Assessment is an essential part of the learning process and this progress report contains information about your child's learning. This report includes a written teacher comment for 4 key areas - Global Competency, Literacy, Numeracy and PE as well as an engagement level for all subjects in the table at the end. The Global Competency is selected as the key area of development from the 6 Global Competencies linked to our school curriculum. The 6 Global Competencies (or 6 Cs) are: **Communication, Collaboration, Critical Thinking, Citizenship, Creativity and Character.**

Engagement levels are one way that we assess how students are connecting with their learning. The table below provides more information about what these levels mean in student-friendly language.
